**Suggested Ideas for
Council Activities**

- Plan a well organized membership drive, maintain personal contact;
- Plan a community event such as a Membership Tea, CWL Luncheon, hold a CWL Day with fun activities and invite all women of your parish;
- Set up a CWL Center (table, posters or bookcase) with promotional materials (Be League, League Magazine);
- Prepare a CWL newsletter. Keep members informed by using bulletin boards, Provincial and National websites, social media;
- Be visible - wear your pin and scarf to all CWL events;
- Become involved in parish ministries;
- Have membership forms available in the church;
- Add Council activity articles regularly in your parish bulletin;
- Order Welcome brochures, Invitation cards from National office. Distribute after Mass;
- Be knowledgeable about the League and share what you know;
- Encourage members to serve in various ministries at a CWL Mass, organize a Spiritual program (day or evening);
- Hold theme meetings: Valentine's, St. Patrick's, Easter, Thanksgiving, Halloween, Christmas;
- Have a door prize at each meeting;
- Involve and educate members on issues relevant to National and Provincial Resolutions by inviting guest speakers;
- Invite a Life Member as a guest speaker to talk of her experiences;
- Write and send special occasion cards presented at Birthdays, Baptisms, Weddings, Anniversaries;
- Give the gift of a year membership to a family member or friend;
- Show appreciation! Praise in public! Present awards, pins, appreciation certificates;
- Hold a special celebration for the Feast of Our Lady of Good Counsel;
- Encourage your Parish Priest to speak about the League; and
- Speak positively about the League!
